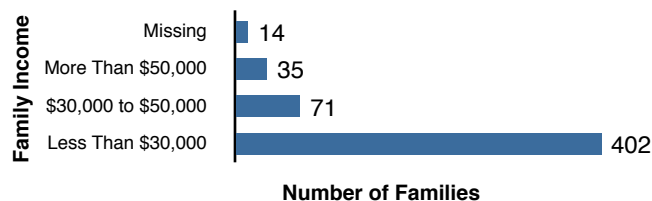
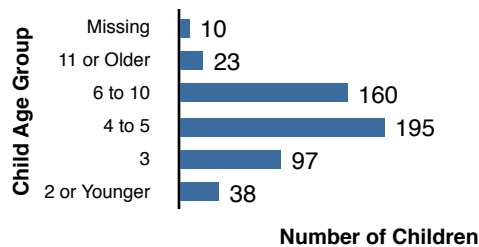
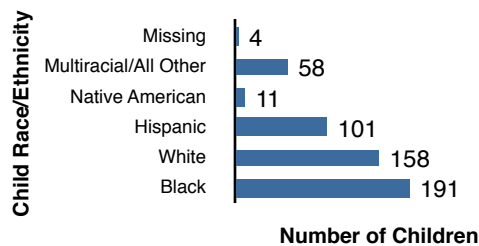




Incredible Years (IY) Evaluation Overview

For the period of July 2011 through June 2012, 57 IY series (groups) were conducted with a total enrollment of 599 parents/caregivers, representing 522 families (523 children). These series (groups) provided 388 sets of matched pre-test/post-test evaluation instruments for this report.*

Key Demographics (All Participants)



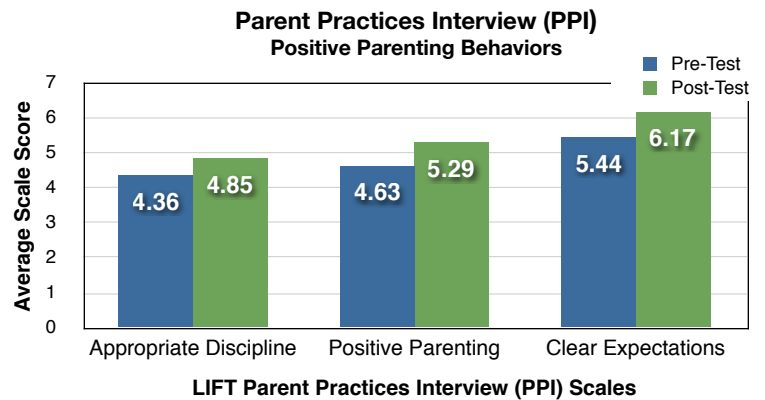
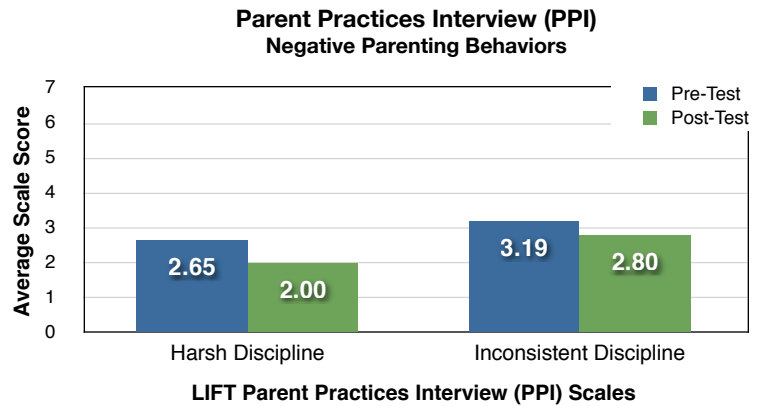
Findings

FY 2011-2012 analyses of individual subscales show an overall positive impact of the Incredible Years BASIC Parent Program on parenting skills and child behavior. The term “**statistically significant**” indicates mathematical confidence that a result is reliable and unlikely to have been produced by chance.

Parenting Skills: Parent Practices Interview (PPI)

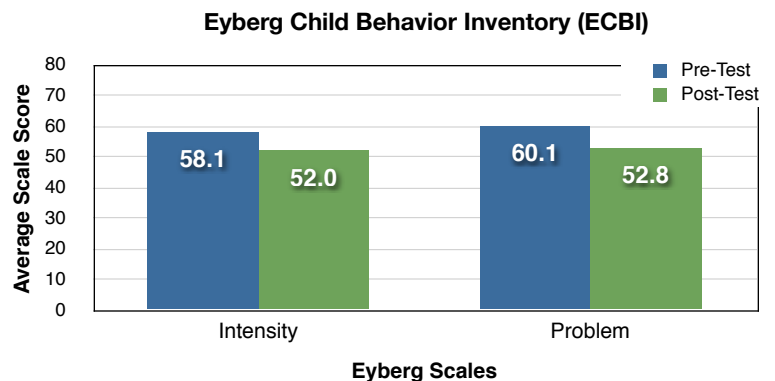
- Caregivers reported a **statistically significant decrease** in their use of Harsh Discipline and Inconsistent Discipline.

- Caregivers reported a **statistically significant increase** in their use of Appropriate Discipline, Positive Parenting and Clear Expectations.



Child Behavior: Eyberg Child Behavior Inventory

- Caregivers reported a **statistically significant decrease** in the frequency of children’s challenging behaviors.
- Caregivers reported a **statistically significant decrease** in the degree to which the behaviors are problematic.
